#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

- One in five Memphians live in poverty according to the 2010 census.
- Memphis was rated the hungriest city in America in a Gallup survey in 2010.
- The Gallup survey found that 26% of Memphians were unable to feed their families at some point over the past twelve months.
- The unemployment rate in Memphis and the 8 surrounding counties was 9.4% in January, 2012.
